

# Federal-Aid Surface Transportation Program

**6 Million Dollar Program**

**Policies and Procedures**

*Effective 6/29/20*

Purpose:

The federal highway bill, allows the use of federal Surface Transportation Program, STP, funds for roadway construction projects on the County's Major or Minor Collector system. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation, ODOT, had allocated to all 77 counties 6 million dollars per federal fiscal year. A project ranking system was developed to distribute this limited funding and be fair as possible to everyone. Originally, the Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma, ACCO, Board and the County Advisory Board, CAB, approved a ranking system. In 2016 the ACCO Board move the responsibility of this program to the Oklahoma Cooperative Circuit Engineering Districts Board, OCCEDB.

Policy:

Beginning in Federal Fiscal Year 2021, the 6 million dollars of STP funds will be divided by a prorata share of the number of counties within a CED on a Federal Fiscal Year basis. If a county moves into a different CED, the corresponding amounts shown below will be adjusted.

The existing program that has projects scheduled out to Federal Fiscal Year 2020 will be continued and funded as already approved by the ACCO board. Those policies and procedures will be followed and enforced by the OCCEDB board.

The existing projects may swap years within the existing program, 2017 thru 2020, if approved by the OCCEDB board. If the project is not complete and ready to be funded by Federal Fiscal Year 2020, that project's funding will become the responsibility of the corresponding CED where the project is located. This CED will have to determine whether this project is funded.

Any remaining or unapportioned STP funding within this program will be reapportioned to other ready/complete projects by the OCCEDB board.

After Federal Fiscal Year 2020, each CED can determine how their apportionment of the 6 million dollars is spent, on roadways (Major or Minor Collectors) or on bridges. These projects will be included in the CED's multiyear construction plan.
